

AGREEMENT MADE APRIL 19, 1999

BETWEEN:

DAVID HARRIS, of the City of Toronto,  
hereinafter called "the Father"

-and-

MATTHEW HARRIS, CAITLIN HARRIS,  
JAMES HARRIS and ANDREW HARRIS, hereinafter  
referred as "The Kids"

Whereas it is made known by the Father to the Kids that there has been just too much damn playing of video games at the Kids' House to the point where the Father is really pissed off;

And whereas the term "video games" herein includes, but is not limited to, Nintendo 64, Play Station and any game of an electronic or computer nature without any redeeming educational value in the uncontrolled discretion of the Father;

And Whereas the Father has offered to the Kids a bribe of a huge size because it seems that they just will not stop playing video games;

And whereas Matthew Harris, one of the Kids is somewhat concerned that he still does not have his Lazy Boy Chair since he upset the Father on his birthday last October, 1998;

Now this agreement shows that the Kids and the Father have agreed to the following terms to resolve these issues, ie the Kids have accepted the Bribe in the terms and conditions as set out in this agreement:

1. Effective on the signing of this agreement, the Kids agree that all video games and related software shall be given to the Father;
2. The Father shall allow the Kids access to the video games and software for purposes of selling same;
